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Post Operative Instructions

EYELID REDUCTION

- 1. Sleep on 2 or 3 pillows to keep the head elevated. This will reduce swelling.
- 2. Moisten gauze with saline and place on your eyelids as tolerated. This is soothing and reduces discomfort.
- 3. **If there is severe pain or visual impairment contact us immediately –** this would be an extremely unlikely occurrence.

For lubrication of the eyes:

Day: "Tears Plus" (optional)

Night: "Visco-Tears Gel"

Tears Plus	Stinging and burning
Visco-Tears Gel	Mild transient burning, sticky eyelids, blurred vision
